










# 35,936 commits by about 960 people

- lterate on the GNOME Shell design to address pain points
- Stay secure and maintain privacy







#### A bit more productive


- Enhancements to online accounts
- Search integration in the shell
- Fine-grained control of notifications





### Iterating on the Shell

- Offering alternative workflows through GNOME Classic and shell extensions
- Ul Improvements around the message tray
- Greater Privacy Controls

- More GNOME 3-style apps:
  - Weather & Notes
  - Music & Videos
  - Transfers (file transfers)
- **GNOME** on Wayland in 12 months
- **GTK** widget improvements






### Outreach Program for Women
